

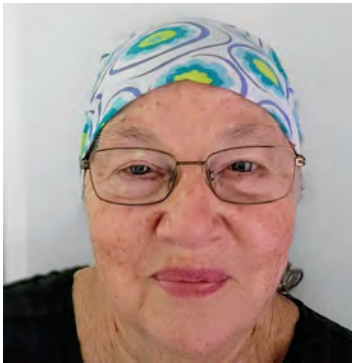

- 3) **Connections Across the Church:** Strengthening relationships among, parish, diocesan, provincial, and national ECW groups through gatherings, shared resources, and collaborative ministry.
- 4) **Equipping and Empowering Women:** New tools, conversations, and leadership development opportunities that help women respond faithfully to the needs of their communities.
- 5) **Faith in Action:** Meaningful service projects and partnerships that reflect Christ's love through compassion, generosity, and justice.
- 6) **Joyful Witness:** Celebrating the stories, milestones, and faithful work at Episcopal Church Women across the Church, encouraging one another in hope.

With God's guidance, the new year invites Episcopal Church Women to continue shining Christ's light—faithfully, courageously, and together.

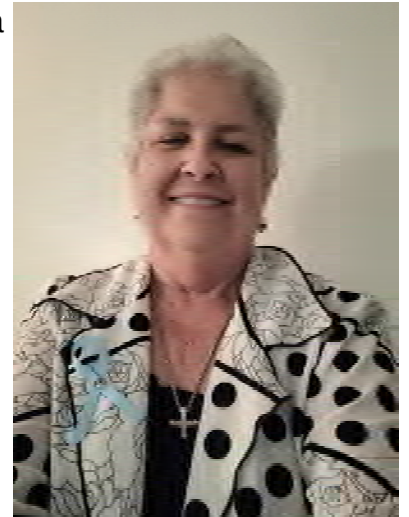


Western North Carolina ECW is planning a fall event with Province IV ECW President, Andrea Geiger who will be our keynote speaker.
